Our Certified Instructor Program (CIP) offers a dynamic, interactive course to give you the knowledge and skills to deliver ELI's award-winning training to your co-workers.

Our train-the-trainer program consists of a three-day, hands-on workshop where participants learn the foundation of ELI's training philosophy, methodologies and course content. You will experience a Civil Treatment® course as a participant, and then have the opportunity to present course segments yourself.

- Day 1 – Participants assume the role of a manager and experience the Civil Treatment for Managers (CTM) course as demonstrated by a master trainer.
- Day 2 – Participants serve as facilitators and practice facilitating two modules from the CTM course.
- Day 3 – Participants serve as facilitators and practice facilitating one module from the Civil Treatment for Employees course.

You may attend one of our hands-on workshops in Atlanta or other locations. Certification sessions are also available at your site if you have a minimum of three instructor candidates. Or, you may opt to participate in our web-based, virtual certification.
