CASUAL CONVERSATIONS

Topics:

- Mutual banter

Learning Points:

- Harassment and retaliation may occur between co-workers.
- Mutual banter is inappropriate joking that is disruptive to workplace productivity and morale.
- The workplace environment is anywhere business is conducted.

OFFSITE CONDUCT

Topics:

- Expectation for offsite conduct

Learning Points:

- Involvement in offsite conversations where sex is referenced can damage reputations.
- Questionable behavior (e.g., excessive alcohol consumption) is not suitable for business meetings.
- Employees should consider individuals involved, location and purpose of the meeting, and behavior being displayed when interacting with co-workers outside the workplace environment.
